About Father Joe's Villages

Established in 1950 to serve San Diegans experiencing homelessness and poverty, we have grown into the region's largest provider of residential and supportive services for homeless neighbors. Father Joe's Villages houses nearly 1,800 individuals daily—from infants and adolescents to adults and seniors. In 2016, we provided services to 13,592 people.

We target San Diego County residents experiencing homelessness and poverty—from infants and adolescents to adults and seniors. Services are offered from our main campus in downtown San Diego, encompassing more than three city blocks; San Diego's Regional Task Force on the Homeless reports this central region has the highest concentration of homeless neighbors in the county (59%). Additionally, we operate multiple scattered-site housing programs throughout San Diego.

Our goals are to offer individualized options that move homeless neighbors into housing as quickly as possible and to offer wraparound supportive services that help homeless and impoverished neighbors obtain and maintain stable housing.

State of Emergency

In 2015, the City of San Diego declared an affordable housing emergency for the 12th year in a row, and the crisis persists today due to rising rents and home prices, low vacancy rates, and the soaring number of homeless residents.

In November 2016, KPBS reported the average price of a single family home in San Diego increased 6% since 2015, the average cost to rent increased 8% since March 2016, and the apartment vacancy rate dropped to 2%.

Client Success Story - Monti

A former resident of Father Joe's Villages provides one example of the complicated circumstances that cause homelessness and the benefit of our services or programs.

After serving his term in a correctional facility, Monti found affordable housing out of reach. He had unexpectedly gained custody of his two young sons, Melvin and Monti Jr., and with no other family and nowhere to go, Monti turned to Father Joe's Villages. He benefited from our transitional housing and supportive services to forge his family's path out of homelessness.

"When my two sons were dropped on me with no place to live, no food, no clothes, nothing, nada, I thought to myself, 'I need to get into Father Joe's Villages no matter what'," Monti shared. "Without Father Joe's I wouldn't be where I am today, in my own home, a job, with my boys; it really turned me around, it opened a path for me, but a path where I had to put the footwork in just as much as they did offering it to me."
