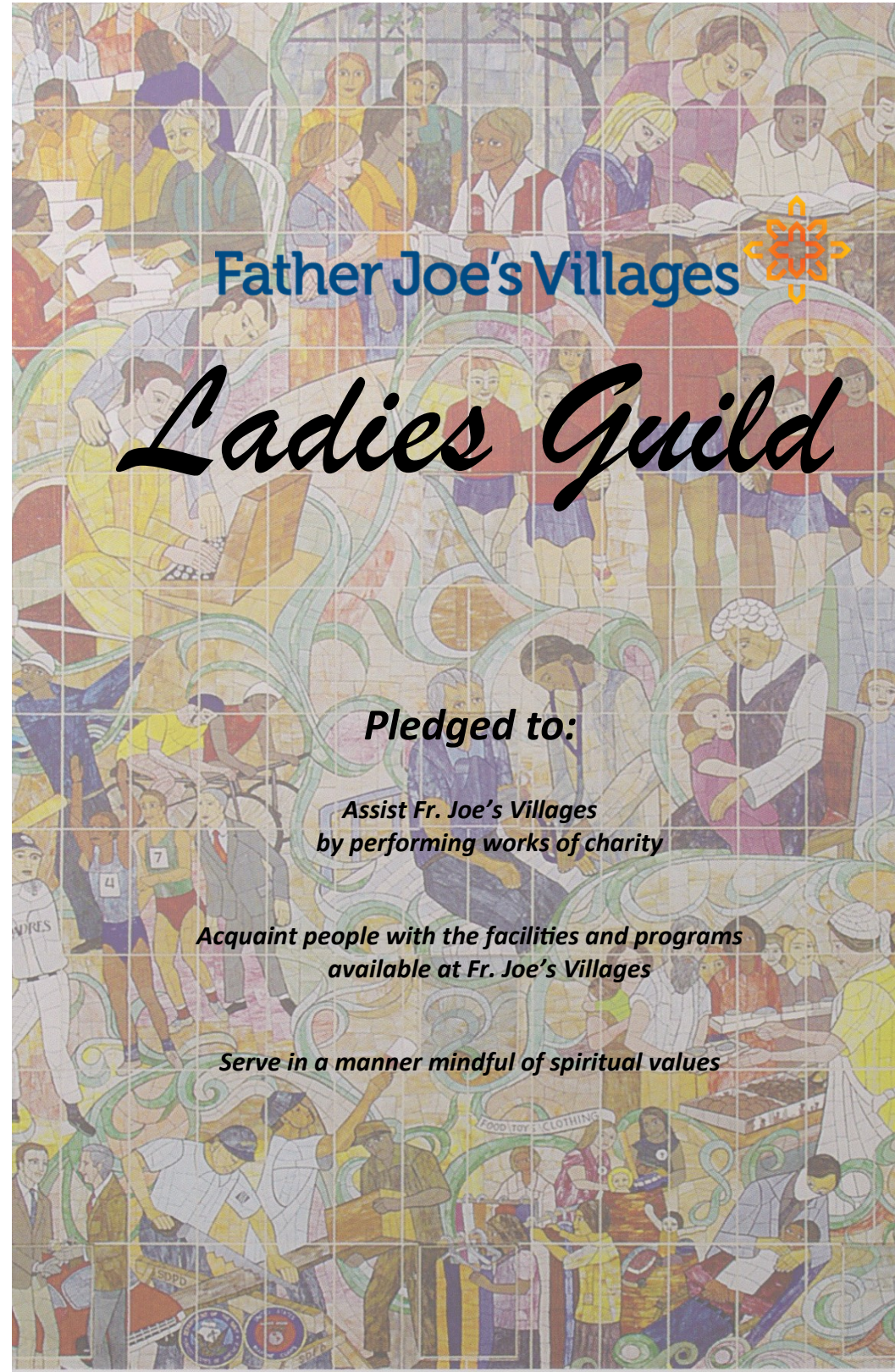

The Ladies Guild was started in 1983 by Father Joe Carroll to assist St. Vincent de Paul Village (as it was then called) in achieving its mission of preventing and ending homelessness in San Diego, one life at a time.
